PRE-ADVENT FAYRE Saturday 25th, after 6pm Mass & Sun 26th Nov, after 9.30 & 11.30am Mass only.

The proceeds from this year's fayre will go to **Aid to the Church in Need**. ACN works to support persecuted Christians across the world and is working particularly hard at the moment to help displaced Christians in the Middle East return to their homes.

In Syria, war-torn families are struggling to buy food as the cost of living has spiralled since the outbreak of civil war. The price of wheat flour has increased by 300% and rice by 650%; Father Andrzej Halemba, ACN's Middle East project head described an "appalling daily struggle to buy food" endured by Christians and others. As a result, ACN is working directly with local Church leaders to support thousands who are at risk of starvation. In total 148 countries benefit from the work of ACN. Donations received leave their ACN offices at the end of each month, so the funds get to where they are most needed.
