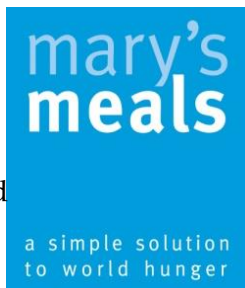
MARY'S MEALS is a charity that sets up school feeding programmes in communities where poverty and hunger prevent children from gaining an education.
