13th September 2020 is EDUCATION SUNDAY

For well over one hundred years there has been an annual recognition of Education Sunday in England and Wales. It is a national day of prayer and celebration for everyone in the world of education.

The theme for 2020 will be "A learning people in a time of change".

This year Education Sunday takes place at a time when many children, young people and staff have been away from schools, colleges and universities and have been working in different ways. Churches, too, have had to learn and adapt, whilst still maintaining a pattern of worship. This is a time to think about what we have learnt about ourselves, about our communities and about God.

Let us pray that more families come together to pray; that more children learn how to pray and have a fresh desire for the Bible, learning from their parents, aunties, uncles, grandparents, teachers or wider church family. We pray that more families come closer to Jesus, and are strengthened and encouraged by learning to pray together.

PARISH DONATIONS / GIVING - We are pleased to announce that we can now accept cashless donations for the Parish by debit and credit cards from all the major card schemes, using the handsets at the back of Church. On the handset screen are a number of amounts you can choose, but if these do not suit you, you can choose a different amount to donate. You can donate contactlessly, or you can insert your card into the keypad where you can authorise your donation using your card's PIN.

You will be asked to register for Gift-Aid, and you would only have to do this the first time you donate. You will need to register on the machine, even if you are already registered as a Gift-Aider with the parish.

If you want to donate to the Parish Collection in cash, there are baskets at the back of Church. If you would like to give regularly by standing order, please contact the Parish Office. Many thanks.

WEDDINGS: Please make sure you give us at least 6 months' notice when applying to get married in a Catholic Church.

BAPTISMS: Usually these take place on the 1st Saturday of the month, but other dates can be agreed should there be the need. Please ring the Parish Office for enquiries.

REQUESTING A MASS INTENTION: If you know the date you would like a Mass Intention for, please request it as far ahead as possible, and we will endeavour to accommodate the date asked for. If an urgent need for prayer arises, we will do our best to shift an existing Intention, with the agreement of the donor of course.

Reporting abuse

If you are concerned about the welfare of a child or adult at risk, do not delay in contacting the police, using 999 if a child or adult is believed to be in immediate danger.

It is the policy of the Catholic Church in England and Wales to report all allegations of abuse to statutory authorities, regardless of whether the abuse occurred recently or in the past, or whether the accused person is living or deceased.

If you are in any role within the Catholic Church in England and Wales, you must refer allegations directly to the safeguarding office for your diocese or religious congregation, or directly to the Police.
