Today, 15th December, is GAUDETE SUNDAY

On our Advent journey, today is when we shift our reflection from "the Lord is coming" to "the Lord is near." We rejoice as we light the pink candle on our Advent wreath - we are more than half-way to Christmas! This third Sunday of Advent is called "Gaudete" Sunday based on the first word of the Latin Entrance Antiphon for this day, meaning "Rejoice", taken from **Philippians 4:4,5**: "Gaudete in Domino semper" ("Rejoice in the Lord always"). Since Advent is a penitential season, the priest wears purple vestments, but on Gaudete Sunday, having passed the midpoint of Advent, the Church lightens the mood a little and the priest wears rose vestments. This is the Church's way of further heightening our expectation as we draw ever nearer the Solemnity of Christmas. Providing us with encouragement to continue our spiritual preparation is another reason why the third candle of the Advent wreath, which is lit on Gaudete Sunday, is traditionally rose-coloured.
