TODAY the Church celebrates the feast of the Presentation of the Lord

which occurs forty days after the
birth of Jesus, and is also known as
Candlemas day, since the blessing
and procession of candles is included
in today's liturgy. Until 1969, the
ancient feast of the Presentation of
Our Lord, which is of Oriental origin,
was known in the West as the feast of the
Purification of Our Lady, and closed the
Christmas Cycle, forty days after the Lord's
birth.

In some Churches, certain elements taken from the Gospel account of the Presentation of the Lord (Lk 2, 22-40), such as the obedience of Joseph and Mary to the Law of the Lord, the poverty of the holy spouses & the virginity of Our Lady, mark out 2nd February as a special feast for those at the service of others in the various forms of consecrated life.
