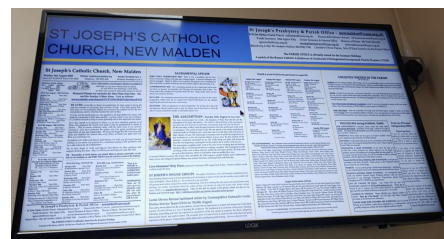
The PARISH OFFICE is officially closed during this time, but you can still contact us via the email address above.

**PARISH DONATIONS / GIVING** - We are pleased to announce that we can now accept cashless donations for the Parish by debit and credit cards from all the major card schemes, using the handsets at the back of Church. On the handset screen are a number of amounts you can choose, but if these do not suit you, you can choose a different amount to donate. You can donate contactlessly, or you can insert your card into the keypad where you can authorise your donation using your card's PIN.

You will be asked to register for Gift-Aid, and you would only have to do this the first time you donate.

**NB.** You will need to register on the machine, even if you are already registered as a Gift-Aider with the parish. If you want to donate to the Parish Collection in cash, there are baskets at the back of Church. If you would like to give regularly by standing order, please contact the Parish Office. Many thanks.

**BOOKING FOR MASS IN CHURCH** - Because of the restricted numbers we can accommodate, we have a booking system in place. Details of how to book online are on our website and displayed at our streamed Masses. Please call **07585 710679** if you do not have access to the internet.

**Face-coverings:** please note and let others know that this is a pre-requisite of entering the church, and you will not be able to come in without one.

**Track and Trace:** In compliance with the government's Track & Trace programme designed to limit the spread of COVID 19, we are required to keep for 21 days the contact details of all attending Mass, after which they will be destroyed, so please be understanding if you are asked to provide this info.

**REQUESTING A MASS INTENTION:** If you know the date you would like a Mass Intention for, please request it as far ahead as possible, and we will endeavour to accommodate the date asked for. If an urgent need for prayer arises, we will do our best to shift an existing Intention, with the agreement of the donor of course.

## From our Diocesan Safeguarding Office

### *Reporting abuse*

*If you are concerned about the welfare of a child or adult at risk, do not delay in contacting the police, using 999 if a child or adult is believed to be in immediate danger.*

*It is the policy of the Catholic Church in England and Wales to report all allegations of abuse to statutory authorities, regardless of whether the abuse occurred recently or in the past, or whether the accused person is living or deceased.*

*If you are in any role within the Catholic Church in England and Wales, you must refer allegations directly to the safeguarding office for your diocese or religious congregation, or directly to the Police.*

*If you are a member of the public, please refer allegations directly to the police and also to the safeguarding office in your diocese.
