ADVENT 2023 Liturgical New Year B

As we continue on our Advent journey towards the birth of the Christ Jesus on Christmas Day, we hear in the Gospel reading today, about John the Baptist preaching in the wilderness of Judaea promising that: 'Someone is following me, someone who is more powerful than I am, and I am not fit to kneel down and undo the strap of his sandals. I have baptised you with water, but he will baptise you with the Holy Spirit.' What are we

doing to make sure our hearts and minds are ready for His arrival? As we light the second purple candle on our Advent Wreath in our churches and our homes, representing PEACE, let us pray for all those around us who are struggling with finding their inner peace, that they may be granted the grace to allow Jesus in the fount of all that is good and peaceful. We also pray that world rulers let Jesus into their hearts, and look towards that which brings true and lasting peace and happiness, and not allow themselves to be ruled by greed and hatred.
