Today we are encouraged to Rejoice as we remember that Lent is nearing its end and so we get a foretaste of Easter Joy. The first word of the Introit is 'Rejoice', in Latin '*Laetare*', hence the name for this special Sunday. The celebrants wear rose-coloured garments rather than the more sombre purple of the rest of Lent, to reflect the imminence of Easter. Let us continue to prepare our hearts and minds as we move through the darkness of these forty days into the Light of the Risen Christ.

Today is that special day every year, when we remember our mothers, grandmothers & other nurturing females in our life. We thank them all for what they do and have done for their
