NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER FOR PRISONERS AND THEIR FAMILIES

Today we direct our thoughts & prayers to the needs of prisoners, their families and children, to pray for them and to reflect on the ways we can make a difference to the lives of those who are affected by the criminal justice system. The COVID-19 pandemic has brought many challenges to those in prison, those who care for them, and to families who have found it more difficult to travel and visit their loved ones. It is also possible to volunteer your time to those affected by imprisonment.

Today we are holding a second collection for PACT, the national Catholic charity supporting prisoners, people with convictions, defendants and their families. PACT is a shining example of strength and conviction, and continues to bring hope in what is always a very difficult environment - hope to families and children who have suffered prolonged separation; hope to those confined to their cells for 23 hours a day for over a year.
