ASH WEDNESDAY - 14th February

"Repent and believe in the Gospel," or "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return"

These are the words we hear as we receive the freshly blessed Ashes at Masses this Wednesday 14th - Ash

Wednesday. These rather sombre words, symbolising death, mourning and repentance, are the introduction to the 40 days that follow - Lent - where we prepare our hearts, souls and minds for the great Feast of Easter. After his Baptism in the Jordan, Jesus spent 40 days in the desert, where we are told he was tempted by the devil three times. However, led and fortified by the Spirit, Jesus was able to stand fast against all temptations. May we also, during the next 40 days, allow ourselves, in our weakness, to be guided and supported by the Holy Spirit as we strive to *Pray, Give Alms, and Fast* as a shining beacon to all those we encounter in our daily lives.
