The BAPTISM of the LORD

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord is observed every year on the Sunday after January 6 (The Feast of the Epiphany), which this year falls on January 12th. It commemorates the baptism of Jesus in the River Jordan by John the Baptist. This special event is also observed as a feast by other Christian Churches, as well as the Eastern Orthodox Church. On this day we are invited to not only think about the Baptism of the Lord Jesus but also of our own baptism, the start of our own personal journey with Christ.

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord is the liturgical link that connects the Christmas season to Ordinary Time. During the Christmas season we pondered the Incarnation, Nativity, Presentation in the Temple, and Epiphany. Today, we see Jesus manifesting Himself to the world as He began His three years of public ministry.

The Sundays that follow, leading us to the Season of Lent, are known as Ordinary Sundays, when no particular aspect of the mystery of Christ is celebrated, but rather the mystery of Christ is honoured in its fulness, especially on the Sundays. "On the first day of the week, which is known as the Day of the Lord, the Church, by an apostolic tradition that draws its origin from the very day of the Resurrection of Christ, celebrates the Paschal Mystery. Hence Sunday must be considered the primordial (original) feast day." (*Missal p. 130,4*).

The Year of Jubilee – a 5 week course in our parish for everyone

Pope Francis has designated 2025 as the Year of Jubilee for the Catholic Church with the theme 'Pilgrims of Hope'. "Jubilee" is the name given to a particular year. A time to re-establish a proper relationship with God, with one another, and with all of creation. In the Catholic Church, the concept of Jubilee or 'Holy Year' was used to declare special years for forgiveness and reconciliation.

The Jubilee of Hope began in December 2024 with Pope Francis opening the "holy door" in St. Peter's Basilica, offering the world's 1.3 billion Catholics the possibility of obtaining a plenary indulgence and a year of special graces. The Jubilee of Hope will end on the feast of the Epiphany in 2026. Pope Francis asked that 2024 be a 'Year of Prayer', as a preparatory year for the Jubilee Year of 2025. We are running a short course, based on talks from the Sycamore Catholic Teaching Resource, for all parishioners to prepare for this year together in small groups. The course will run on a **Tuesday night from 8pm to 9.15pm** in St Joseph's church hall.
