### THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

The common theme flowing in today's Mass Readings is WATER. In the First Reading, the Israelites, forgetting all that God had done for them, complained to Moses of their thirst and tiredness, feeling abandoned by Him. God responded to Moses's desperate plea on their behalf by giving him the power to produce endless flowing water from a dry rock - replenishing the people's physical and spiritual thirst. In today's Gospel, Jesus says to the Samaritan woman at the well - a woman of a different religious tradition, and shunned by the Jews: 'Whoever drinks this water will get thirsty again; but anyone who drinks the water that I shall give will never be thirsty again: the water that I shall give will turn into a spring inside him, welling up to eternal life.' With these words, Jesus promises eternal life to all who seek it and accept it, no matter what their background or belief. May we, like the Samaritan woman, believe the words of Jesus and let the power of the Holy Spirit flow within us, so that others may also see and believe.
