TODAY'S READINGS

This Sunday falls between Ascension and Pentecost, and today's readings continue to follow the development of the infant Church, a very exciting time for the apostles as they go forth spreading the Word.

The Gospel for this Sunday is the same one every year, from John, and it is made up in its entirety of a prayer by Jesus to his Father. He prays for his disciples to be kept faithful and true to the teachings he had passed on to them; that they be protected

from the evil one and be consecrated in the truth. Let us pray in the words of today's Collect that we may, like the original disciples, experience His abiding presence throughout our earthly life:

Graciously hear our supplications, O Lord, so that we, who believe that the Saviour of the human race is with you in your glory, may experience, as he promised, until the end of the world, his abiding presence among us. Who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. **Amen**.


CATHEDRAL MASS CELEBRATING MARRIAGE
