TODAY IS EDUCATION SUNDAY

Today we hold a 2nd collection for the CATHOLIC EDUCATION SERVICE, which acts on behalf of the Catholic Bishops' Conference to support Catholic education. This service has a strong and positive working relationship with the British and Welsh governments, sharing the aims of high academic standards for all, and increased parental choice. Catholic schools make up 10% of the national total of maintained schools. There are over 2,000 Catholic schools, academies and colleges in England and Wales, educating over 800,000 students. The Catholic Church and the Church of England together provide one-third of all of the schools in the country. The CES is the chief negotiating and advisory body on matters affecting all aspects of Catholic education, and it also provides financial assistance for school transport in rural areas.

MEMORIAL SERVICE

During the last 18 months many people have had bereavements, and lost loved ones. As we know, during lockdown very few people could attend the Funeral, and some could not even have a church service. We are going to have a Memorial Service for all those we have known that have died since the beginning of the pandemic.

It will be held in the Church on **SATURDAY 6th NOVEMBER at 2pm.** Everyone is invited, so that we can support one another.
