TODAY - SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER (A)

It is very obvious, in today's readings, that we are being prepared for the arrival of the Holy Spirit, on Pentecost Sunday, celebrated in a couple of weeks. In the First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles, the feeling of excitement is palpable, as the apostles, led by Philip and later joined by Peter and John, preached the Good News to the people of Samaria, who, in the main, opened their hearts to them and received the Holy Spirit joyfully, as the Apostles laid their hands on them. In today's extract from John's Gospel, Jesus continues to teach the disciples as they sat together at the Last Supper. He offers them encouragement as his moment of suffering and crucifixion draws near, and reassures them that, although he would be leaving them soon, he would by no means be abandoning them. Rather, he would be sending 'another Advocate', the first having been himself, who would continue to guide them and fill them with the courage and determination they would need to continue their mission. Although He had to return to the Father, the Holy Spirit would stay with them forever and through him, God's love would be fully revealed to them.
