## BOURNEMOUTH ORATORY IN FORMATION

Fr Peter Edwards' new parish, Sacred Heart, Bournemouth (which is the Bournemouth Oratory in Formation) needs to raise over £2 million pounds to cover essential refurbishment of both the Presbytery and the Parish Halls At the moment, the and offices. Presbytery is uninhabitable, with major hazards to health such as asbestos and unsafe water supply, plumbing and electrics, resulting in the Oratorian Fathers and Brothers having to live in temporary accommodation. Despite this, they are continuing to feed more than 100 homeless people 3 times per week in their dilapidated hall.

As part of their major fund-raising project, a monthly series of concerts and recitals is being organised in their beautiful church. This month's event on Saturday, 20th October at 7pm is a Concert of Sacred Music by local choir, Sutton Chorale, to which some of our parishioners belong. Please see the posters in the Narthex for further details and please consider making a trip down to Bournemouth to support this and future events. It's an opportunity to help the Bournemouth Oratorians in their time of need and to assist those, like the homeless, who are dependent upon their support.

The Oratory is a 20 minute walk or short bus ride from the main station and there are several car parks close by.
