## Today is HOME MISSION Sunday - *Evangelii Gaudium*

In 2013, the first year of his pontificate, Pope Francis released an Apostolic Exhortation on the joy of the Gospel titled *Evangelii Gaudium*. In it, he encouraged the Christian faithful to "embark on a new chapter of evangelisation":

*We cannot forget that evangelisation is first and foremost about preaching the Gospel to those who do not know Jesus Christ or who have always rejected him. Many of these are quietly seeking God, led by a yearning to see his face... Christians have the duty to proclaim the Gospel without excluding anyone.* *Evangelii Gaudium*, §14

This is the challenge and opportunity we take up on **Evangelii Gaudium Sunday**. Formerly known as Home Mission Sunday, *Evangelii Gaudium Sunday* is celebrated each year on the third Sunday in September - today the 15th.

The theme this year is 'Growing as missionary disciples' - It gives us an opportunity to reflect on the great mandate we have been given by the Risen Lord to evangelise the whole world. "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations," the Lord commissions, as we hear in Matthew 28:19.

**THE BROWN SCAPULAR** comprises of two small pieces of brown cloth usually bearing the images of Our Blessed Lord and Our Blessed Lady. The images are joined together with a cord worn over the shoulders. There are no special prayers or devotions associated with wearing the scapular, but wearers seek the protection of Our Lady and pledge themselves to the service of Jesus Christ.

As with all religious observances it should lead us closer to Jesus. There is a short ceremony of enrolment in which the scapulars are blessed, and certain prayers are said. The recipient then becomes part of the wider Carmelite family. The brown scapular is a sacramental bestowing - and other graces - on the wearer in right relationship with God. By wearing the scapular, we try to "put on" or clothe ourselves with Mary's attitudes and emulate her virtues. With the aid of Our Lady's intercession, we seek to humbly serve God and neighbour.

This will take place after 10 am Mass on the last Saturday in September (28th). Anyone interested in formally being enrolled in the scapular please notify the Parish Office. Brown scapulars can be provided free of charge to anyone who does not own one. There is more info on last week's bulletin.

## CHANGE IS COMING!

At the beginning of Advent this year the translation of the Bible used in readings at all Masses will change. Currently the Catholic Church uses the "Jerusalem" translation. This will change to the "English Standard Version" with Abbey Psalms and Canticles. This means that, from Advent, our current missals will no longer contain the translation of the readings which will be used during Mass. A sing-up sheet will be put up in the narthex - anyone interested in purchasing a new missal should add their name to this list. It costs £19.95 making it an ideal Christmas present. Once we have an idea of numbers we can order sufficient copies of the missal in time for the change.
