Today is the feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel

(superseded by the Sunday Liturgy)

The name given to the Blessed Virgin Mary as the patroness of the Carmelite Order, is Our Lady of Mount Carmel, or Virgin of Carmel. In the late 12th and early to mid-13th centuries, Christian hermits first settled on Mount Carmel in the Holy Land and became known as Carmelites. They constructed a chapel in the middle of their hermitages and dedicated it to the Blessed Virgin and later became known as the Brothers of Our Lady of Mount Carmel.

Mary is invoked by Carmelites both as Mother and as sister; she is one who walks with them on their journey of faith and whose example they can follow as disciples of Jesus.

Let us join the Carmelite family in our parish in prayer for the protection and intercession of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. We also remember in a special way our first Parish Permanent Deacon - Deacon John Sampson, who passed away on her feast day thirteen years ago. May he continue to Rest in Eternal Peace.

We also wish a Happy Feast Day to all who bear the name Carmel, Carmen, etc.
