DAY FOR LIFE - SUNDAY 16TH JUNE 2019

This year the Day for Life will focus on all those who are suffering or have survived domestic abuse. It provides an opportunity to pray, reflect, and choose the ways in which action, as well as practical and emotional support, can ensure the dignity of human life is upheld at every stage of a person's life. Following discussion at the Synod on the Family, about this topic, Pope Francis wrote, 'Unacceptable customs still need to be eliminated. I think particularly of the shameful ill-treatment to which women are sometimes subjected, domestic violence and various forms of enslavement which, rather than a show of masculine power, are craven acts of cowardice. The verbal, physical, and sexual violence that women endure in some marriages contradict the very nature of the conjugal union.' (Amoris Laetitia 54).

ST JOHN'S SEMINARY - Chapel Challenge Appeal. The Seminary, near Guildford, Surrey, which has been involved in the formation of priests for over 125 years, is looking for some help with the cost of re-decoration and refreshment of its Chapel - dedicated to the Sacred Heart - which last received attention in the 1980s.
