FOLLOW ME - WHERE ARE YOU GOING?

Jesus is calling each one of us to a personal encounter with Him. The "Follow Me" course leads us into this personal encounter through study of St John's Gospel. The course consists of a DVD talk then discussion, over 8 sessions starting in January. These sessions will take place in houses all around the parish with a choice of days and times.
