IN TODAY'S GOSPEL FROM MARK, we see the extent of Jesus's compassion. He had been teaching and preaching, whilst the Apostles had been doing the same elsewhere. None of them had had time to rest or eat. Iesus attempts to find a more deserted part on the shores of the Sea of Galilee, but they were followed. Despite being exhausted, Jesus took pity on the people, and continue to teach them. Jesus also demonstrates to us the importance of rest and
