## TODAY IS EVANGELII GAUDIUM SUNDAY

The Third Sunday in September, formerly called Home Mission Sunday, is now *Evangelii Gaudium Sunday*. Named after Pope Francis' first (solo) Apostolic Exhortation on the Joy of the Gospel, the day offers the Catholic community in England and Wales the opportunity to celebrate the beauty of our faith and our commitment to witness to the fullness of life in Christ.

There are Novena cards at the back of church for you to help yourself to, where the the Archbishop invites us to pray for 3 people who have not yet returned to church and to pray the novena, which starts this Sunday 18th September, for their return. More information can be found on the card itself.

The second collection today is for the Catholic Agency for the Support of Evangelisation, supporting the spread of the Gospel in our own country.

## QUEEN ELIZABETH II RIP

Today Sunday 18th September, there is a Solemn Sung Requiem Mass for the repose of the soul of our late Queen, at 12noon at St George's Cathedral. All are welcome, in person or online - link here - <https://youtu.be/ZwB-VnaorHo>.
