FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT ~ LAETARE SUNDAY

Today we are encouraged to Rejoice as we remember that Lent is almost over and we get a foretaste of Easter Joy. The first word of the Introit is 'Rejoice', in Latin 'Laetare', hence the name for this special Sunday. The celebrants wear rose-coloured garments rather than the more sombre purple of the other Lenten Sundays, to reflect the imminence of Easter. Just as Jesus healed the blind man in today's Gospel and gave him sight, may our sight be also renewed as we move through the darkness of these forty days into the Light of God, who is the Risen Christ, celebrated on Easter Sunday.
