## FEAST OF ST JOSEPH THE WORKER

Today we celebrate the second of two feasts of dear Patron, St Joseph. The first day dedicated to him is the 19th March, when we remember him as the husband of Mary. Today we celebrate him as a worker, a humble carpenter, doing his best as most parents do, to make ends meet and provide for his family. Pope John Paul II once said of him: *'Saint Joseph is a man of great spirit. He is great in faith, not because he speaks his own words, but above all because he listens to the words of the Living God. He listens in silence. And his heart ceaselessly perseveres in the readiness to accept the Truth contained in the word of the Living God.'* We do not learn much more from the scripture about Joseph, but we know that, although he came from the royal lineage of King David, he was a poor man, humble and always unquestionably obedient to the will of God. He looked after and treasured the family entrusted in his care. On this **DAY OF PRAYER FOR BLESSING ON HUMAN WORK**, we can have no better example to look to, than St Joseph the Worker. May we like him, be able to recognise the blessings and satisfaction found in a job well done, and be always thankful to God for the work he puts our way, even though at times it may feel daunting and difficult. *St Joseph, Pray for us and Guide us in our work.*
