Today's Gospel, from

Luke 10:38-42, recounts the very familiar story of Jesus visiting the home of Martha and Mary. In this passage, Martha is busy preparing and serving, while Mary is sitting at Jesus' feet, listening to his words. Jesus tells Martha that Mary has chosen the better part, highlighting the importance of prioritising

spiritual nourishment over worldly tasks. Martha has become a symbol of the active life, and Mary that of the contemplative life. For us Christians, the key

lies in being able to combine these two - close union between action and contemplation can be achieved in very different ways, depending on the specific vocation each person is given by God. We must all thrive as much as possible to find a healthy and harmonious balance between the two in our daily lives.

Stories from Israel-Palestine

(at All Saints Church, Kingston)

Between January and April 2024 the Very Reverend Nicholas Papadopoulos, Dean of Salisbury, spent three months' sabbatical leave volunteering in occupied East Jerusalem with the World Council of Churches' Ecumenical Accompaniment Programme in Palestine and Israel, which he describes as 'an overwhelming experience'. The sensitively handled talk will include these topics and more:

- What is daily life under occupation really like?
- What are the implications for human rights and international law?
- What can be done to promote a just peace in Israel-Palestine?
