CONFIRMATION 2022



TODAY IS THE SOLEMNITY OF CHRIST THE KING

This great feast brings to a close the Church's Liturgical Year - the current Year C. Next Sunday sees the start of Advent and the Liturgical Year A, from



which all the Sunday readings will be taken for the next 12 months. There's no better way to give glory and honour and praise to our Lord and King than by echoing this Sunday's Collect:

Almighty ever-living God, whose will is to restore all things in your beloved Son, the King of the universe, grant, we pray, that the whole creation, set free from slavery, may render your majesty service and ceaselessly proclaim your praise. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.

Today we also celebrate NATIONAL YOUTH SUNDAY - very appropriate in our parish this year as our young people receive the very special Sacrament of CONFIRMATION. We pray for young people in our parish and everywhere, so that they continue to be guided along the right path and be ambassadors for the Church and all that is right and just.


