### THE FEAST OF THE BODY & BLOOD OF CHRIST

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body & Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) established by Pope Urban IV in 1264, a year after the Eucharistic miracle at Bolsena where a consecrated host began to bleed onto the corporal. It is a reminder that when the bread and wine are

consecrated at the altar during Mass, they become literally the body, blood, soul, and divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ. Not a symbol, not a personification, but the real body and blood. God who loves us so much nourishes us with his very self. A love which is available to all who hunger and wish to take it. It is only through the Lord, in the taking of his body and blood, that our hunger and thirst is truly satisfied.
