FEAST OF JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

The Feast of Christ the King, also called Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, is celebrated in the Catholic Church in honour of Jesus Christ as Lord over all creation. It brings to an end the church's Liturgical year. This feast was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 as an antidote to secularism, a way of life which leaves God out of human thinking and living and organises life as if God did not exist. The feast is intended to proclaim in a striking and effective manner Christ's sovereignty over individuals, families, society,

governments, and nations. Jesus Christ is alive, he is risen, and he continues His redemptive mission now through the Church, of which we are members. Almighty ever-living God, whose will is to restore all things in your beloved Son, the King of the universe, grant, we pray, that the whole creation, set free from slavery, may render your majesty service and ceaselessly proclaim your praise. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.

Today is also **NATIONAL YOUTH SUNDAY**, when we pray for all our young people that, as they journey through life, they will always remember to look to God and the Saints for help, guidance and example. We have a 2nd collection in support of youth work in the diocese and beyond, especially the Southwark Catholic Youth Service.
