Today is EVANGELII GAUDIUM (HOME MISSION) SUNDAY

In 2013, the first year of his pontificate, the late Pope Francis released an Apostolic Exhortation on the joy of the Gospel titled Evangelii Gaudium. In it, he encouraged the Christian faithful to "embark on a new chapter of evangelisation", striving to find new paths to proclaim the Gospel in today's world. This is the challenge and opportunity we take up this Sunday. Formerly known as Home Mission Sunday, Evangelii Gaudium Sunday is celebrated each year on the Third Sunday of September.
