CORPUS CHRISTI THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (C)

This great feast honours Jesus Christ, Really, Truly and Substantially Present under the appearances of bread and wine. This happens through the change which the Church calls transubstantiation "change of substance",

when at the Consecration during Mass, the priest says the words which Christ Himself pronounced at The Last Supper over bread and wine, "This is My Body," "This is My Blood," "Do this in memory of Me." The Solemnity of Corpus Christi falls on the Thursday following Holy Trinity Sunday, but it is transferred to the nearest Sunday - this year 22nd June - in our diocese and many others. *There are many lay people who have received the privilege of distributing the Body & Blood of Christ at Masses and homes by being commissioned as Extra-Ordinary Minister of Holy Communion. At all Masses this weekend, after the homily, there will be an opportunity for them to renew their commitment to serve as an EMHC. If you know of anyone who you believe to be a potential EMHC, please email their name to the parish office or speak to one of our clergy.*
