THE BROWN SCAPULAR, as with all religious observances, should lead us closer to Jesus. After the 10am Mass **THIS SATURDAY** 28th September, there is a short ceremony of enrolment in which scapulars are blessed, and certain prayers are said. The recipient then becomes part of the wider Carmelite family. By wearing the scapular, we try to "put on" or clothe ourselves with Mary's attitudes and emulate her virtues. With the aid of Our Lady's intercession, we seek to humbly serve God and neighbour.

CHANGE IS COMING!

At the beginning of Advent this year the translation of the Bible used in readings at all Masses will change. Currently the Catholic Church uses the "Jerusalem" translation. This will change to the "English Standard Version" with Abbey Psalms and Canticles. This means that, from Advent, our current missals will no longer contain the translation of the readings which will be used during Mass. A sing-up sheet will be put up in the narthex - anyone interested in purchasing a new missal should add their name to this list. It costs £19.95 making it an ideal Christmas present. Once we have an idea of numbers we can order sufficient copies of the missal in time for the change.
