Pilgrimage to Pentecost Activities for Pilgrimage to Pentecost

The archdioceses of Southwark have launched a series of events to support the Year of Jubilee. There are four main events to be held during Eastertide in celebration of the Year of Jubilee.

1. Pilgrimage to Pentecost Course (starting Tuesday 27th April for 6 sessions)
2. **The centrepiece of the Archdiocese's Jubilee celebrations will be a festival of prayer and activities for all parishioners and families, at The Friars, Aylesford on Saturday 7 June 2025. We will have coaches leaving from St Joseph, for which there will be sign-up list soon.**
3. Archdiocese of Southwark Jubilee Pilgrimage from St George's Cathedral to The Friars, Aylesford on Monday 2 June to Saturday 7 June 2025
4. Daily Scripture-based reflections: grounded in scripture and tradition (with a Pentecost Novena for the 9 days leading up to Pentecost Sunday).
