Details of LENTEN COURSES in our PARISH

“**The Chosen**” is an extremely popular TV drama series that brings Jesus and his time on earth to life in an authentic and factual way. Your prayer time will be changed by this experience.

This Lent the Parish will show series 1 of “The Chosen” - 8 sessions - each Wednesday in the Pastoral Centre, starting 21st February at 7pm.

The 'Dare to Say Our Father' 5 week course uses a booklet produced by the Agency for Evangelisation and Catechesis and will be run in our parish this Lent. PRAYING THE ROSARY - We invite parishioners to pray the rosary to Our Lady of Fatima outside in our Marian Garden. This will continue to take place after the 10am Mass on the first Saturday of every month. We next meet on Saturday 2nd March. Praying together strengthens our faith and it is a way of evangelising and being a witness to our faith.

THE NATIONAL NOVENA TO ST JOSEPH will take place from 10th – 18th March 2024 at St Joseph’s Church in Maidenhead. Every year, the Mill Hill Missionaries prepare for the Feast of St Joseph, their Society Patron, with a special Novena of Masses and prayers to ask for God’s blessing on their Society’s missionary outreach, and for the intentions of all those who support their work.
