It's a great blessing that, with God's Grace, we have been able to continue with our physical Masses at St Joseph's in the ever increasingly uncertain times that we find ourselves in.

Our Mass Stewards have been doing a stellar job of keeping everyone safe and comfortable every day, and we hear this from many of our regular parishioners as well as other visitors, so renewed thanks to all.

Of course we must not forget Fr Uche, who celebrates Mass for us daily, and can always be relied on to provide an inspiring and thought-provoking homily.

We would remind our parishioners that for this to continue, everyone needs to follow the instructions of the stewards, who are there to help with matters directly related to the Mass they are attending.

Please do not approach the stewards for general enquires relating to Sacraments, School Forms, etc - this will restrict the free flow of people entering the church, and compromise everybody's safety. These type of queries should be addressed by contacting the Parish Office directly.

Another observation has been that people tend to gather in significant numbers outside church after Mass - please keep to the rule of 6 at all times and keep your distance. We all need to do what is needed to keep our church open and everybody safe.

Lastly, Fr Uche has taken the decision to uncover the statues - this is to enhance your experience when in church - we would remind everyone that the statues are not to be touched.

SUNDAY 1st NOVEMBER - FEAST OF ALL SAINTS

On this day the Church commemorates every saint, known and unknown.

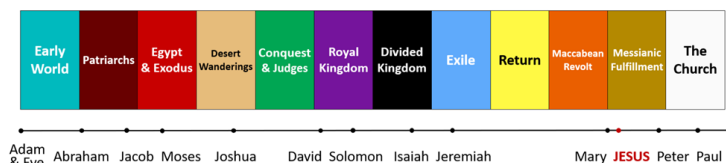
Although many of the known saints have their own feast day during the year, on November 1st the Catholic Church remembers them all through the Solemnity of All Saints. For the saints that we do not have as much information about, or for those whose feats are still relatively unsung, this day offers an opportunity to commemorate their accomplishments and to pray to them, asking for their intercession.

All Saints Day was formally established in 609 AD by Pope Boniface IV, although it was then held on May 13. The pontiff also created All Souls Day which is now held one day after the feast of all saints on November 2nd.

The date November 1st was eventually chosen in 835 AD by Pope Gregory III and was made a Holy Day of Obligation by Pope Gregory IV in the 9th century.

Thank you, God, for the tremendous sacrifices made by those who have gone before us. Bless the memories of your saints, God. May we learn how to walk wisely from their examples of faith, dedication, worship, and love. In the honour and noble victory of the martyrs.

SACRAMENTAL UPDATE

CONFIRMATION perfects Baptismal grace; it is the sacrament which gives the Holy Spirit in order to root us more deeply in the divine filiation, incorporate us more firmly into Christ, strengthen our bond with the Church, associate us more closely with her mission, and help us bear witness to the Christian faith in words accompanied by deeds. (CCC 1316)

St Joseph's Confirmation preparation programme begins in January 2021. We welcome all young people in Year 9 and upwards to register and prepare to receive this auspicious Sacrament. The Programme consists of an Enrolment Mass, twice monthly sessions starting on Zoom with additional activities and a retreat. The Sacrament will be conferred in July 2021.

BOOKING FOR MASS IN CHURCH - Because of the restricted numbers we can accommodate, we have a booking system in place. Details of how to book online are on our website and displayed at our streamed Masses. Please call **07585 710679** if you do not have access to the internet. **Face-coverings:** Please note and let others know that this is a pre-requisite of entering the church, and you will not be able to come in without one.

Track & Trace: In compliance with the government's Track & Trace programme designed to limit the spread of COVID 19, we are required to keep for 21 days the contact details of all attending Mass, after which they will be destroyed, so please be patient if you are asked to provide this info. NHS COVID-19 APP - As you may be aware, the new NHS covid-19 app is now available to all to allow for contact tracing. It is available to download for free on the google play store and apple app store. The current advice is to get the app if possible. Amongst other things, this app enables you to scan the QR code at a venue to record your attendance - this will then help with NHS track and trace.

We are making this available at St Joseph's from this weekend. However, we must emphasise that this will not replace booking online for Mass. Therefore please continue to book on line as you would normally do where at all possible. If you turn up not having booked, the stewards will be offering you this facility, which of course can only be used if you have the app on your phone.

Reporting abuse

If you are concerned about the welfare of a child or adult at risk, do not delay in contacting the police, using 999 if a child or adult is believed to be in immediate danger.

It is the policy of the Catholic Church in England and Wales to report all allegations of abuse to statutory authorities, regardless of whether the abuse occurred recently or in the past, or whether the accused person is living or deceased.

If you are in any role within the Catholic Church in England and Wales, you must refer allegations directly to the safeguarding office for your diocese or religious congregation, or directly to the Police.
