St Joseph's parishioners helped Fr Joseph Luzindana realise the dream of building this Centre, as one of our Lenten Charities around 10 years ago. With ever increasing numbers using the centre, of course, the cost of running and upkeep has also grown beyond imagination.

This Centre started as a home, in answer to a cry for help from the vulnerable, marginalised and neglected children near Kampala and far beyond, most of whom are living in extreme poverty and are orphans.

When these children and young people arrive at the centre, they are received with kindness; their needs are met in every way possible. They are provided with education, rehabilitation, counselling and spiritual and social advice. The aim of Fr Joseph and his helpers is to bring these poor youngsters love, hope and confidence and show them they matter, so that they can grow and enjoy God's love like other, more fortunate children.

Fr Joseph will be telling us more at all Masses this weekend.
