ADVENT 2022 Liturgical New Year A

Today marks the start of our spiritual period of preparation for the celebration of Jesus' birth on Christmas Day. It is also the beginning of a new Liturgical Year - A. The readings for the 1st Sunday of Advent Year A speak of readiness for the coming of Jesus Christ. In the first reading from the prophet



Isaiah, we hear that God will establish His kingdom and we must be ready to walk in His Light. In the second reading Paul, in his letter to the Romans, warns us to be awake and prepared, as our salvation is near at hand. In the Gospel Jesus echoes this warning not to be unprepared, as people were in the days of Noah 'The Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.' This is a time to prepare for our Lord to come into our hearts and minds and be ready to celebrate his birth.

Let us take out our Advent Wreath and start lighting the candles, one for each of the four Sundays of Advent - a purple one on the first, second and fourth, the pink one on the third Sunday, giving us hope that salvation is near, and the white one in the centre on Christmas Day, symbolising Jesus as the centre of our lives!

St Joseph's Advent Charity 2022

We hope to raise funds for a borehole project In Dandou Kissidougou which is on the border between Guinea and Sierra Leone. This is a very rural area with no access to schools, churches, health-care and other facilities. For the many poor villagers living there, there is only one source of drinkable water and it would be around a mile walk away - on rough terrain - for most people. With the money we raise, it is hoped that one or more new boreholes are sunk especially in the vicinity of the church, where the Christian families worship. Christians are in a great minority so this would make a huge different to their well being and give them a sense of worth and support, greatly missing in an area such as this. All our second collections during Advent will go towards this project. If any parish groups have other fund-raising ideas please let the parish office know. Please be generous. God Bless you all.
