DIGNITAS INFINITA THE VATICAN DECLARATION ON HUMAN DIGNITY

Dignitas Infinita explores the concept of human dignity from many angles, and comes firmly to the conclusion that it is neither a legal fiction nor a human intervention, but an intrinsic property of all human life from conception to death.

The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales welcomes this declaration on human dignity, and writes:

'In our troubled times, it is important for Christians to proclaim the inherent and unconditional dignity of all human beings, without exception, as being the basis of authentic human rights. Although human rights have increasingly been codified in secular documents, such as in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, our dignity and rights originate in the Gospel preached by Christ'.

It adds: 'It is our hope that recognition of this shared responsibility will strengthen the social action of the Catholic Church in England and Wales, and transform our civil and political life'.
