

## THE ASSUMPTION - Thursday 15th August 2024

The Feast of the Assumption of Mary is a very important day in our Catholic faith - it is even called the 'Easter of the Summer' in some parts of Europe. Also known as the 'Dormition of the Virgin Mary', it is the principal feast of the Blessed Virgin, the Mother of Jesus Christ. This feast commemorates two events - the departure of Mary from this life and the assumption of her body into heaven. The Church's official doctrine of the Assumption says that at the end of her life on earth Mary was assumed, body and soul, into heaven. Some mistakenly say Mary "ascended" into heaven, which is incorrect according to the Bible. It was Jesus Christ who ascended into heaven, by his own power. But Mary was assumed or taken up into heaven by God. Observed as a holy day of obligation by Catholics and as a public holiday in some countries, the Feast of the Assumption is considered as Holy Mary's "heavenly birthday" and this is not a day of mourning for her loss, but a celebration of joy for the union of the mother with her beloved son.

As this is a religious holiday, the Assumption is most commonly celebrated by attending Mass, where the subject of the sermon is usually the Virgin Mary. In many Catholic countries, there are also outdoor festivities including bands and fireworks.

We will be travelling by coach to visit two historic centres of Catholic interest:

- 1. **Stonor House**, near Henley on Thames, is an old Catholic Stately Home which has been in the hands of the same family for over 700 years and where Mass has been celebrated in their chapel without a break throughout the penal times.
- 2. **Littlemore**, on the southern outskirts of Oxford, where John Henry Newman founded a celibate community of Anglican clergymen in the early 1840s and where he was formally received into the Catholic Church in 1845.

We will meet at St Joseph's for the 10.00 am weekday Mass that day and depart afterwards on our pilgrimage, returning to St Joseph's by around 6.30 pm.
