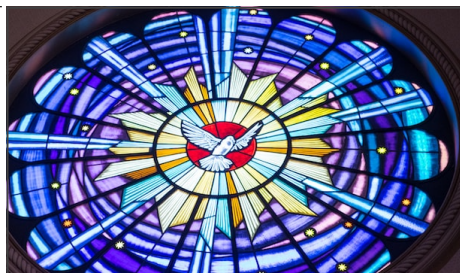

PENTECOST (A)

Today marks the end of the Easter Season - Paschaltide - 50 days since the greatest feast of the Church, as we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, the feast commemorating the foundation of the Church - its birthday if you like! Today we pray afresh for the 7 gifts of the

Holy Spirit, bestowed upon us on our Baptism and then sealed through the Sacrament of Confirmation. Let us all pray fervently for: *WISDOM, UNDERSTANDING, COUNSEL, FORTITUDE, KNOWLEDGE, PIETY, and FEAR OF THE LORD.* It is a very useful exercise to ponder on these seven attributes and look further into their meaning and message. Although of course it is Jesus alone who possesses these traits in full, he freely shares them with us all, inviting us to be ever receptive to the promptings of the Holy Spirit in our lives, making us grow in holiness and rendering us fit for Heaven.

Let us today also pray in a special way for our Confirmation Candidates as they continue on their journey towards receiving this great Sacrament later on in the year. We pray also for their catechists, walking beside them, and for success in our search for a new Co-ordinator for 2024.

Come, Holy Spirit, fill my heart with your heavenly fruits: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, trustfulness, gentleness and self-control, that I may, by faithful submission to your inspiration, merit to be united eternally with you in the love of the Father and the Son. Amen.

SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Trinity Sunday celebrates God in three persons - Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The Church's teaching on the Trinity, "is the central mystery of Christian faith and life." St Athanasius is even more direct when he says that upon faith in the Trinity, "the church is built, and if anyone were to lapse from it, they would no longer be Christian." The trinity is the perfect union of the lover (father) the beloved (son) and the fruit of that unitive love (Holy Spirit). We see pale reflections of that union in this life through the life of the family with the union of a man and woman in love and children coming as a result. It is a reminder for all of us that we are obliged to love all as Christ and the Father loved each other and as God loves us in revealing his Trinitarian nature.
