THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

(The official end of the Christmas Season)



Today the Church celebrates the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord which occurs forty days after the birth of Jesus and is also known as Candlemas Day, since the blessing and procession of candles is included in today's liturgy.

(Blessing of Candles and Procession at the live-streamed 11.30am Mass).

In today's Gospel we see Mary and Joseph offering the sacrifice prescribed for the poor: a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons, as they took Jesus to the Temple in Jerusalem to present him to the Lord, as was expected of them, according to the Law of Moses.

Simeon and Anna were two venerable elderly people so dedicated to prayer and fasting, that their strong religious spirit rendered them able to recognise that the child being presented was the Messiah.

Now the Holy Spirit had revealed to Simeon that he would not die before he had seen the Christ Jesus. When he saw Jesus, he took him up in his arms and blessed God and said what is known as the *Nunc Dimittis* - the song of Simeon: 'Lord, now you are letting your servant depart in peace, according to your word; for my eyes have seen your salvation that you have prepared in the presence of all peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and for glory to your people Israel.'

THE YEAR OF JUBILEE – a 5 week course in our parish for everyone

Pope Francis has designated 2025 as the Year of Jubilee for the Catholic Church with the theme 'Pilgrims of Hope'. "Jubilee" is the name given to a particular year. A time to re-establish a proper relationship with God, with one another, and with all of creation. In the Catholic Church, the concept of Jubilee or 'Holy Year' was used to declare special years for forgiveness and reconciliation.



The Jubilee of Hope began in December 2024 with Pope Francis opening the Holy Door in St. Peter's Basilica, offering the world's 1.3 billion Catholics the possibility of obtaining a plenary indulgence and a year of special graces. The Jubilee of Hope will end on the feast of the Epiphany in 2026. Pope Francis asked that 2024 be a 'Year of Prayer', as a preparatory year for the Jubilee Year of 2025. We are running a short course, based on talks from the Sycamore Catholic Teaching Resource, for all parishioners to prepare for this year together in small groups. Remaining three sessions. all on <u>Tuesday nights from 8pm - 9.15pm</u> in St Joseph's church hall.


