**In Matthew's Gospel today**, Jesus concludes the instructions & support he's been giving to the Apostles over the past few weeks. He tells them, and all who would succeed them, that they must be prepared to undergo great sacrifices, even death itself, if called on to do so for His sake. Although they did not fully understand what he meant, when the time came, they remembered his words and gladly suffered imprisonment, hardships, and finally martyrdom for Christ. It was the resurrection of Christ, and the descent of the Holy Spirit on them at Pentecost that transformed them from mere worldly creatures into brave and fearless heroes. They understood that Christ was the Son of God who had come on earth to bring all to heaven. They became fully aware of how transitory, and unimportant, the few years of our life here on earth are, when compared to the eternal life with Jesus, to follow.

Kingsway CLC Trust & Lighthouse Alliance are keen to bring the new Christian film *Lifemark* (PG) into UK cinemas.

Odeon want to be confident that there will be a worthwhile audience before committing to screen it nationwide. So they are trying it out in a few cinemas, Kingston and Wimbledon being two of these.

If it goes well in these test cinemas, it should be possible for *Lifemark* to be shown at Odeons all around the country.

Something similar happened last November when *C.S. Lewis: The Most Reluctant Convert* was tested in 12 UK cinemas. The following week this rose to 60 cinemas including retaining it at all 12 trial cinemas.

**So it is really important that *Lifemark* opens well in Kingston and Wimbledon.**
