

# REVERENTIAL TREATMENT OF THE SACRED HOST

Very sadly and worryingly we are still regularly finding Sacred Hosts on the floor of the church, mainly after weekend Masses. We find it hard to understand how and why this is happening during Mass, when people going up for Holy Communion are trusted to know the real meaning of the Sacrament. We all have to remind ourselves what it is that we are receiving and what disrespecting it means, and make renewed efforts to avoid this happening in the future. Once you receive the Sacred Host, please take one step to the side and consume it immediately. Please do not walk off with it. Your co-operation is very much appreciated, so that the dignity of the Holy Mass and Communion are upheld.

WARM WELCOMES ~ St Joseph's together with the other churches in New Malden, will be opening their halls this winter to provide a warm place for people who have difficulty paying to heat their homes. Each church will open their hall one day per week, with St Joseph's opening our hall on Fridays. 
# FOUNDATION GOVERNOR VACANCY

NEXT WEEKEND 8 / OCTOBER is Prisoners' Sunday - It is a time when the Catholic Church encourages us to bring prisoners and their families into the hearts and minds of our parish communities, and remember in our prayers those among us affected by the criminal justice system. The Gospel reading for this Sunday in churches this year will be about the healing of the 10 lepers (Lk 17:11-19). In the time of Jesus, lepers were outcast from society. We can think of those affected by imprisonment as similarly being on the margins of society today. One mother whose husband was sent to prison said: 'You lose friends. People were talking about me in the playground'. In this excerpt from Luke's gospel, the lepers call out to Jesus and he helps them, restoring them to their communities. At PACT, the dignity of each person is respected, supporting those affected to make a fresh start, together with their family, and be restored into the community. Next weekend we will have a second collection to support PACT. Please be generous. Thank you.
