THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD - Candlemas

This Wednesday 2nd February 2022 is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, also known as Candlemas, as the blessing of candles normally takes place as part of the liturgy. This feast occurs 40 days after the birth of Jesus, and in some Catholic countries, the Crib and other Christmas decorations are kept on display until this day.

Mary and Joseph took the infant Jesus to the Temple to be presented to the Lord, according to the law: *Every first-born male must be consecrated to the Lord*, and also according to the law, offered in sacrifice two turtle doves or young pigeons.

In the Temple there were Simeon and Anna - two elderly, devout and upright people dedicated to prayer and fasting. Their strong committed spirit made it possible for them both to recognise the baby Jesus as the Messiah. On seeing Jesus, Simeon, to whom the Holy Spirit had revealed that he would not die before he had set eyes on the Christ, uttered a beautiful prayer which is now known as the *Nunc Dimittis*, and is still widely used liturgically in the Catholic and other Christian churches:

*'Now, Master, you can let your servant go in peace, just as you promised;
because my eyes have seen the salvation
which you have prepared for all the nations to see,
a light to enlighten the pagans and the glory of your people Israel.'*

What Simeon and Anna prophesied gave Mary and Joseph much to ponder on - their future as the parents of Jesus did not promise to be easy or straightforward, but they accepted it all with faith and put their trust in God as they had always done. With God's help, may we always aspire to entrust our lives in His hands, as we face life's challenges and tribulations.
