Feast of SS PETER & PAUL (tr. from 29th June)

The Feast of SS Peter and Paul is an annual célebration in the Christian calendar of the lives and deaths of the two great saints: Peter and Paul. This joint feast day is of particular importance because of the enormous influence that these two men had on the development of the early Church.



St Peter, as one of the Twelve Apostles, and many say, their leader, witnessed many of Jesus' teachings and actions. He is portrayed in the New Testament as a bold but flawed follower, who, despite promising never to betray Jesus, denies him three times before the crucifixion. After Jesus' death and resurrection, Peter journeyed far and wide to spread the news of the Gospel and is considered the leader of the Church. He founded the Church in Rome, was the first Pope, and established it as the centre of the worldwide Church. He was later crucified upside down by the order of the Emperor Nero around the year 64 AD.

St Paul, originally known as Saul, had a very different background to St Peter. Saul was a devout Jew and Pharisee from the city of Tarsus and was a great

persecutor of Christians in the first years of the Church. However, he received a dramatic conversion experience on the road to Damascus and was subsequently baptised as a Christian. Saul, thereafter known by his Greek name Paul, travelled across the known world preaching to Jews and Gentiles alike about the Gospel of Jesus Christ.



His influence on the early Church was incredible and cannot be overstated. Paul was beheaded in Rome during the reign of the Emperor Nero, around the year 65 AD.


We have a wall safe to the left of the Sacred Heart Shrine, dedicated to this cause, where you can leave your donations right through July. Many thanks.
