### FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT - LAETARE SUNDAY

Today we are encouraged to Rejoice as we remember that Lent is nearing its end so we get a foretaste of Easter Joy. The first word of the Introit is 'Rejoice', in Latin 'Laetare', hence the name for this special Sunday. The celebrants wear rosecoloured garments rather than the more sombre purple of the rest of Lent, to reflect the imminence of Easter. We prepare our hearts and minds through the 'darkness' of Lent knowing that the Light of the Risen Christ is close at hand.

- 1. Pilgrimage to Pentecost Course (starting Tuesday 27th April for 6 sessions)
- 2. The centrepiece of the Archdiocese's Jubilee celebrations will be a festival of prayer and activities for all parishioners and families, at The Friars, Aylesford on Saturday 7 June 2025. - 3. Archdiocese of Southwark Jubilee Pilgrimage from St George's Cathedral to The Friars, Alyesford on Monday 2 June to Saturday 7 June 2025
