## ADVENT 2023 Liturgical New Year B

Today we begin the season of Advent, the start of our spiritual period of preparation for Jesus' birth on Christmas Day. It is also the beginning of a new Liturgical Year - Year B, a year which focuses our attention of the Gospel of Mark. This Sunday's Gospel reminds us that, in addition to preparing our hearts and



minds to welcome Jesus at Christmas, we must also be ready for Christ's return in glory at the end of time. So, as Jesus said to his disciples: "Be on your guard, stay awake, because you never know when the time will come". Let us take out our Advent Wreath and start lighting the candles, one for each of the four Sundays of Advent a survey on the first accord and fourth, the rink one or

four Sundays of Advent - a purple one on the first, second and fourth, the pink one on the third Sunday, giving us hope that salvation is near, and the white one in the centre on Christmas Day, symbolising Jesus as the centre of our lives!

**MASS READERS** - The start of Advent sees the return of reading from the main Sanctuary Lectern for all readers at all Masses - something that had to stop during the Covid pandemic. All current **Readers have had an email about these changes. Reminder: IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO ADJUST THE MICROPHONE AT THIS LECTERN** - it will pick up your voice anyway. **APPEAL FOR ANAWIM ORPHANAGE HOME** - I am mother Oresoa Selo-Oieme of the Missionary Sisters for the Poorest of the Poor. I run an orphanage with about twenty children based in Edo State, fifty in Abuja Nigeria and thirty children in Ghana.

The children in Edo State are in urgent need of accommodation, which costs £40,000, a borehole for water costing £2,000, and a bus which will cost £14,000.

These are the basic essential needs in order to raise up the children in a more holistic manner to become better citizens.
