SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT 2022 - Year A

As we continue on our Advent journey towards the birth of the Christ Jesus on Christmas Day, we hear in the Gospel reading today, about John the Baptist preaching in the wilderness of Judaea and passionately entreating everyone to 'Repent, for the Kingdom of heaven is close at hand'. This is the same man the prophet Isaiah spoke of when he said: *A voice cries in the wilderness: Prepare a*

way for the Lord, make his paths straight. So again we are reminded to prepare for the coming of the Lord, a theme running throughout all of Advent. What are we doing to make sure we are ready?

As we light the second purple candle on our Advent Wreath in our churches and our homes, representing **PEACE**, let us pray for all those around us who are struggling with finding their inner peace, that they may be granted the grace to allow Jesus in the fount of all that is good and peaceful. We also remember all those in war-torn countries, and pray that the ones instigating the turmoil and unrest, also let Jesus into their hearts, and look towards that which brings true and lasting peace and happiness, instead of allowing themselves to be ruled by greed and hatred.

St Joseph's Advent Charity 2022

We hope to raise funds for a borehole project In Dandou Kissidougou which is on the border between Guinea and Sierra Leone. This is a very rural area with no access to schools, churches, health-care and other facilities. For the many poor villagers living there, there is only one source of drinkable water and it would be around a mile walk away - on rough terrain - for most people. With the money we raise, it is hoped that one or more new boreholes are sunk especially in the vicinity of the church, where the Christian families worship. Christians are in a great minority so this would make a huge difference to their well being and give them a sense of worth and support, greatly missing in an area such as this.
