A PROPHET IS ONLY DESPISED IN HIS OWN COUNTRY

This Sunday's Readings are about continuing to listen to and trust in God in the midst of adversary and rejection - even and sometimes, especially - by those closest to us.

In the **First Reading** the Prophet Ezekiel speaks of how the Lord sent him to the Israelites, to preach to them, even though they were defiant and obstinate and would probably not listen.

Paul, in his **Second Letter to the Corinthians**, talks about the troubles he encountered constantly, and how he had accepted them, and, trusting in the Lord, asked that his weaknesses and the agonies and insults he bore in Christ's name be used as his strength. *'For it is when I am weak that I am strong'*.

In the **Gospel** we hear of Jesus performing miracles in his home town - Nazareth. Although his miracles and teaching were impressive, the people of Nazareth doubted him, because they knew him as a humble carpenter, and would not accept that his wisdom and power were divine. We can sense Jesus's disappointment when he left after a short while, having performed a handful of miracles, curing 'a few sick people'. In this Gospel passage, Mark is foreshadowing Jesus' rejection by his own people, the people of Israel, and also attempts to prepare us to accept this rejection as a possible consequence of Christian discipleship.
