EUCHARISTIC ADORATION AT ST JOSEPH (a parishioner)

Parishioners are reminded that the Church is open for adoration from after the Mass at 10am until 8pm every Thursday. Adoration is the highest reverence to be offered to God, our creator, redeemer and sanctifier who alone should be 'worshipped and glorified.' Furthermore, the adoration of the triune God as God by us is the first act of virtue of religion and the first commandment of the law. It is an opportunity to sit or kneel in church, away from the bustle and turbulence of daily life. We can pray joyously, and reflect in silent adoration in the presence of Christ, looking at the consecrated host in the Monstrance on the altar, with the Tabernacle directly behind it, and Christ on the Cross above. Afterwards we leave at peace totally refreshed and energised. The doors will be open for you!
