The Church has been celebrating the World Day of Migrants and Refugees (WDMR) since 1914. It is always an occasion to express concern for different vulnerable people on the move; to pray for them as they face many challenges; and to increase awareness about the opportunities that migration offers.



Every year the WDMR is the last Sunday of September but this year, on the Jubilee of Migrants, the WDMR is being celebrated this weekend - 4 and 5 October. The theme of Pope Leo XIV's message for the 111th World Day of Migrants and Refugees is: **Migrants, Missionaries of Hope**. In this message, the Holy Father emphasises the important witness that Catholic migrants and refugees can offer in a world affected by conflict and inequality in hoping and searching for a better and more peaceful future. 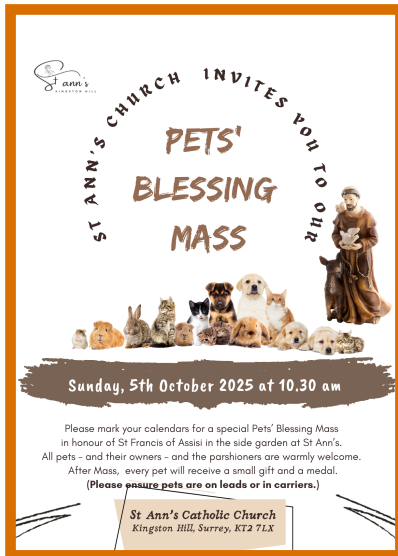

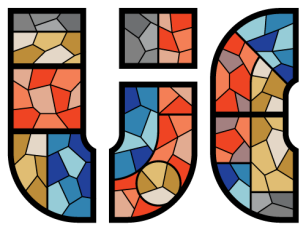

FLU Vaccine: Adults ages 65 and over; Pregnant women and vulnerable people from 6 months of age

RSV Vaccine: Adults aged 75 to 80 years; Pregnant women who are at least 28 weeks pregnant.
